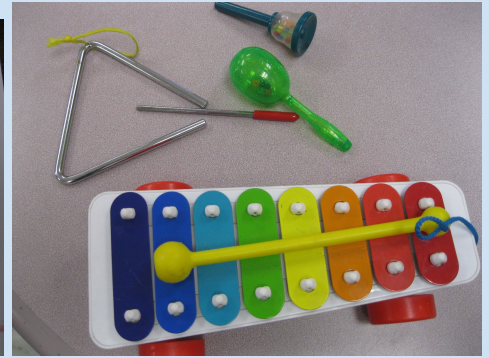
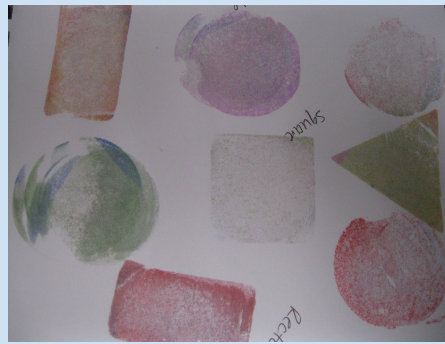
On Monday it Rained

Our stories this week are about family and feelings. We often revisit books to have discussions as a class.

This Week:

We continue to read stories about feelings and school. We talked about feeling sad, worried, and happy. The book *On Monday it Rained* is worth checking out - it talks about a variety of feelings and is a great conversation starter for talking about problem solving.

Small Groups included stamping, identifying, and describing shapes. We used blocks to create patterns and tell what comes next in our pattern. Students engaged in snipping cardstock with scissors (stiff paper is a great way to introduce cutting skills). Students engaged with sink and float activities at the water table.

During center time, students discovered the music center. They explored musical instruments including the xylophone, maracas, and triangle.

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
