Thanksgiving Greetings,

This week we continued our Tree Study by adding a short focus on apples. Apples are a healthy food that goes on trees. On Tuesday, we explored tasting different colors of apples: red, green, and yellow. On Wednesday and Thursday, we reflected on the graph we made and discovered which color apples the students liked most! For a science experience, we used an apple corer and zoodle maker to make apple circle and apple noodles with adult supervision.

During small group, students explored writing letters in shaving cream - it was a hit! We spread shaving cream on trays and the students used their finger or a popsicle stick to write letters. Students interacted with a short story about Thanksgiving at the journal table and then wrote and drew about what they are thankful for.

On Monday, the morning students participated in a Veteran's day parade and assembly. We waved our flags to celebrate the Veterans and then listened to the elementary students sing songs of thanks and appreciation at the assembly.
