We conclude our Tree Study by engaging with the story Ten Apples Up On Top. We noticed rhyming words throughout the story and showed “thumbs up” if we found two words that rhyme and “thumbs down” if we found two words that did not rhyme. Exploring rhyming is a skill that involves listening to letter sounds, a foundational skill for Kindergarten.

During small group, students used dice to count objects onto a ten frame template, and then sorted the objects. Students used tree pictures to draw and label a final tree journal. In our third group, students matched numbers in a tree game.
